- **Bright yellow, trumpet-shaped flowers appearing early and continuing from late spring to early fall**
- **Grows about 6–12 in tall and 8–12 in wide (20–35 cm)**
- **Thrives in full sun to partial shade**

- **Creamy-white petals with sienna-red “cappuccino” eye zones and central yellow flares**
- **Large-flowered, early-blooming cultivar from the Calitastic series**
- **Blooms prolifically from late spring through early fall (May–October)**

- **Mounding, trailing plant with prolific violet-purple, trumpet-shaped flowers**
- **Blooms very early and continuously from spring through fall**

- Mounding, semi-trailing habit ideal for containers, baskets, and garden beds
- Bright magenta blooms with yellow-starred centers in a fun “pinwheel” pattern

- Bright white petals with grape-purple splashes and golden-yellow centers
- Semi-trailing, medium-vigor plant perfect for containers, hanging baskets, groundcover, and mixed beds

## CALIB

### Chameleon Atomic Orange

- Rich blend of orange, scarlet, and yellow flowers that change colors in response to light and season
- Blooms from early spring through fall, with vibrant canopy throughout season

## CALIB

### Chameleon Blackberry Pie

- Flowers show a marbled blend of purple, fuchsia, lavender, and yellow—colors shift with light and temperature
- Blooms continuously from spring through fall, offering nonstop color

### Chameleon Blueberry Scone

- Flowers shift hues (blue-purple, violet, lavender, yellow) throughout the season in response to light and temperature
- semi-trailing, vigorous growth ideal for containers, hanging baskets, window boxes, or landscape beds



## CALIB

### Chameleon Tart Deco

- rich blends of hot pink, violet, yellow, and burgundy depending on light and day length.
- Compact to semi-trailing growth.
- Blooms from early spring through autumn, offering long-lasting color

## CAREX

### brunnea Aureovariegata

- Evergreen clumping sedge with upright, arching leaves edged in creamy-yellow to gold
- Forms neat mounds about 35–40 cm tall and 30–40 cm wide
- Produces small, pale-yellow/cream flower spikes in mid-summer (July–August)

## CAREX

### Comans Frosted Curls

- Evergreen, clump-forming sedge with slender, silvery-green foliage that curls at the tips.
- Forms fountain-like tufts ~20–40 cm (8–16 in) tall and 30–45 cm (12–18 in) wide
- Flowers are small, green-brown spikes in late spring to early summer (not ornamental)

## CAREX

### Evergold

- Evergreen, clumping sedge with narrow, arching leaves variegated in creamy-yellow centers and dark green margins
- Forms neat mounds ~25–30 cm tall and 30–45 cm wide
- Produces small, insignificant pale-brown flower spikes in spring (mainly grown for its foliage)

## CAREX

### Gold Band

- Evergreen, clump-forming sedge with rich green leaves edged in creamy-gold to white
- Grows about 30–40 cm tall and spreads to 45–60 cm wide (typically 10–12" × 18–24")



## CAREX

### Ice Dance

- Evergreen, clump-forming sedge with dark-green leaves edged in creamy white
- Forms arching, tufted mounds about 9–12 in tall and spreads 12–18 in wide
- Small, brown flower spikes appear in late spring—but primarily valued for foliage

## CAREX

### Lax. Bunny Blue

- Semi-evergreen/evergreen, forming neat clumps of striking silvery-blue foliage
- Grows 6–12 in (15–30 cm) tall, spreading 12–18 in (30–45 cm); slower spread via rhizomes

## CAREX

### Morrowi Irish Green

- Evergreen, dense, clump-forming sedge with glossy bright-green foliage
- Reaches approximately 30–45 cm tall and 30–50 cm wide
- Produces small, pale greenish-brown flower spikes in mid-summer, nestled within the leaves

## CAREX

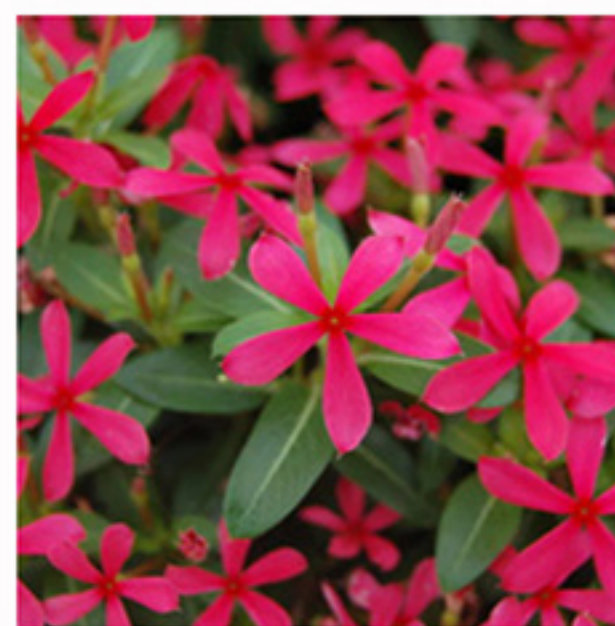
### Vanilla Ice

- Evergreen, clump-forming sedge with glossy green leaves edged in creamy-yellow
- Grows about 30–45 cm tall and spreads 30–40 cm wide
- Produces small, pale flower spikes (cream/greenish-white) in late spring to early summer

## CATHA

### 12847 Soiree White

- Compact, mounded annual with glossy green foliage
- White star-shaped flowers (~4 cm) with a distinctive red/pink center (“peppermint” eye) bloom profusely from spring through frost



## CATHA

### 112851 Soiree Pink white eye

- **Compact, mounding annual with glossy green foliage**
- **Soft-pink flowers (~4 cm) featuring a white eye and tiny yellow center, blooming early and continuously from May until frost**

## CATHA

### 12860 Soiree dark pink white eye

- **Compact, mounded annual with glossy green foliage**
- **Striking flowers: white petals with a bold dark-pink eye (~3–4 cm)**
- **Blooms early (March/May) and continuously through to frost (November)**

## CATHA

### 12861 Soiree Hot Pink

- **Glossy green foliage topped with bright hot-pink, star-shaped flowers (~4 cm across)**
- **Compact mounding habit, reaching 15 cm (6") tall and spreading 30–46 cm (12–18")**
- **Blooms early (May) and continues through frost—reliable summer-to-autumn performer.**

## CATHA

### 12862 Soiree Paprika red

- **Compact, mounding annual with glossy green foliage**
- **Vivid paprika-red, star-shaped flowers (~3–4 cm) bloom profusely from late spring through fall**

## CENTAUR

### Snowy Owl

- **Evergreen annual (or perennial in zones 9–11) forming a cushioned mound ~45 cm tall and wide (~18")**
- **Velvety, silvery-white to gray-green leaves create striking contrast in borders and containers**



## CERAT

### Plumbaginoides

- Glossy oval green leaves all summer, turning burgundy/red in autumn
- Clusters of vivid gentian-blue, phlox-like flowers bloom mid-summer into fall (July–September/October)



## Chrysanthemum

### Prelude apricot

- **Color:** Pale Bronze
- **Lobed leaves and flower heads**
- **leaf Color:** Green Leaves
- **Growth habit:** Bushy
- **Blooming time:** Late Summer to – late autumn



## Chrysanthemum

### Prelude autumn bronze

- **Color:** Bronze Red
- **Lobed leaves and flower heads**
- **leaf Color:** Dark Green Leaves
- **Growth habit:** Compact
- **Blooming time:** Late Summer to – late autumn



## Chrysanthemum

### Prelude dark red

- **Deep burgundy-red, densely double blooms (2–4 in / 5–10 cm across), perfect for cutting or front-of-bed display.**
- **Bloom time:** Midsummer to fall (August–October), offering vibrant autumn color



## Chrysanthemum

### Prelude pink

- **Profuse clusters of semi-double, rose-pink blooms (~3–4 cm across) from late summer into autumn**
- **Compact, rounded habit growing 10–50 cm tall and wide (typically 25–40 cm)**



## Chrysanthemum

### Prelude Popcorn

- **Asteraceae family.**
- **Erect woody-based perennial with aromatic.**
- **Pinnately lobed leaves and flowerheads of diverse form.**
- **Creamy-yellow blooms in late summer and early autumn.**

### Prelude rose pink

- **Compact.**
- **Rounded perennial with aromatic.**
- **Dark green foliage**
- **Flowerheads in shades of pink**

- **Lobed leaves and flower heads**
- **Growth Habit.Compact**

### Xanthe red bronze

- **Features large, semi-double to fully double red-bronze blooms**
- **Grown naturally with no pinching, PGR use, or white-rust sprays, offering an early flowering habit**



## Chrysanthemum

### Xanthe white single

- **Single-flowered cultivar featuring crisp white petals and a central yellow disk (daisy-type bloom)**
- **Ideal for hanging baskets, naturally flowering early in the season without growth regulators or pruning**

## Chrysanthemum

### Xanthe amber

- **Warm amber-bronze, semi-double to fully double blossoms**
- **Naturally early flowering—no growth regulators or pinching needed**

## Chrysanthemum

### Xanthe light bronze

- **Medium-height, bushy plant growing ~45–60 cm (18–24") tall and wide**
- **Produces clusters of semi-double to double light bronze blooms (~5–10 cm across)**
- **Blooms from late summer into fall—excellent for autumn color**

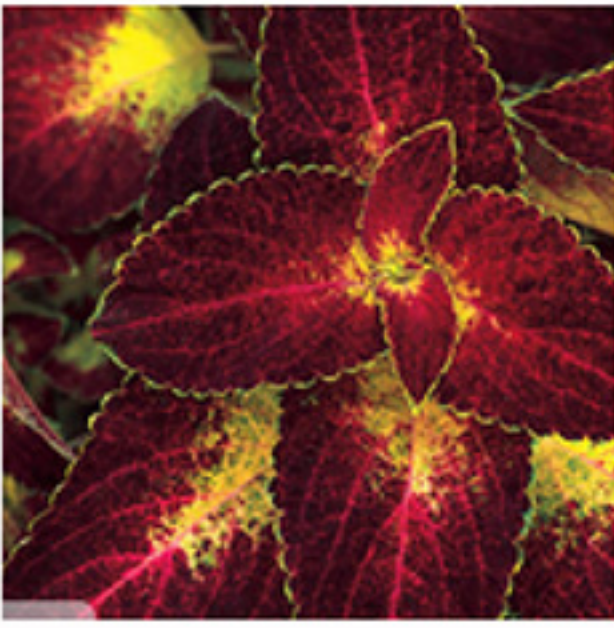

### Dipt in Wine

- **Smooth, Shiny, Rounded leaves are crimson with a lime-green edge**
- **Heat tolerant**
- **Upright growth habit**
- **Red foliage color**

## COLEUS

### Newly Noir

- **Rich purple-black leaves, striking both in shade and sun**
- **Highly adaptable—thrives in full sun to deep shade; best color in filtered light**
- **Upright, thriller habit reaching 60–100 cm tall with a spread of 45–90 cm**

## COLEUS

### Oleo Elliot

- **Fiery orange-bronze leaves with lime-green margins—dramatic contrast and bold impact**
- **Thrives in part shade to full sun; foliage tones deepen with brighter light**

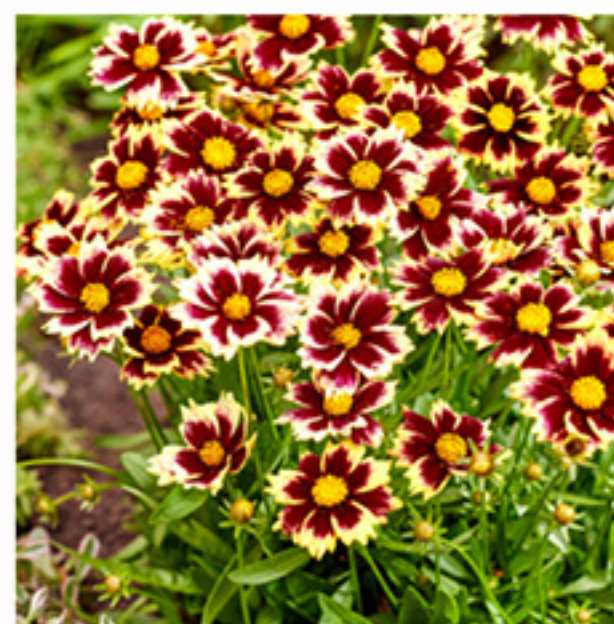

- **Deep orange-bronze leaves edged in bright yellow-green, offering a fiery and tropical visual impact**

- **Fiery orange-bronze leaves edged with bright yellow-green—extremely eye-catching**
- **Upright, shrubby habit reaching 60–90 cm tall and 45–90 cm wide—ideal as a “thriller” centerpiece in containers**

## COLEUS

### Skeletal

- **Deep magenta to burgundy “fronds” intricately lobed like fishbones, edged with glowing lime-green margins**
- **Compact mound, about 25–35 cm tall and wide (10–14 in), perfect for containers or beds**

## COLEUS

### Skyfire

- **Vivid burgundy-red leaves edged in ruffled lime green—striking multicolored contrast**
- **Thrives in full sun to full shade; optimal foliage color and crispness under 4–6 h of sunlight**

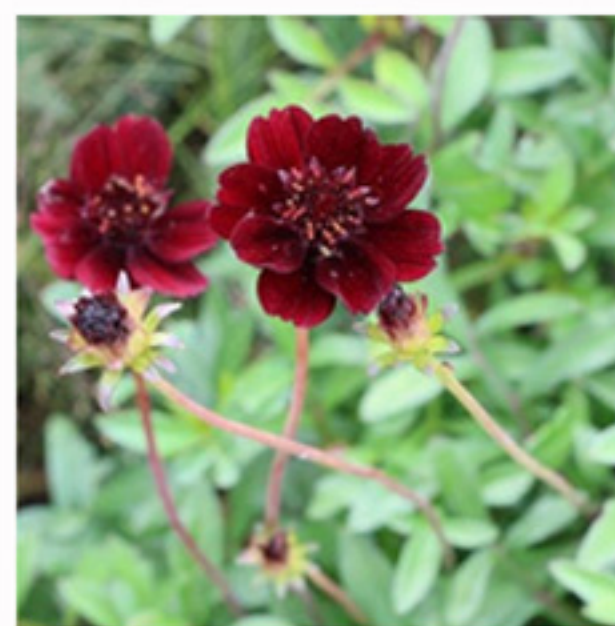
### sabiatus Blue

- **Erect or Scrambling.**
- **Oval leaves with simple or permanent divided leaves.**
- **Open funnel-shaped purplish-blue flowers.**

## COREO

### Solar Fancy

- **Single, daisy-like deep cherry-red flowers (~5 cm across) edged in bright yellow; blooms profusely early summer through fall (June–October)**
- **Neat mounded habit with lush green foliage, holding up well under adverse conditions**



## COREO

### Solar Jewel

- **Bright red flowers with glowing yellow-orange margins, featuring ragged petals for a vibrant daisy-like display**
- **Blooms prolifically from late spring through autumn (June–October)**

## COREO

### Solar Mellow

- **Bright yellow-orange flowers with a striking red-orange center; large, daisy-like petals (~5 cm across), blooming profusely from June to October**
- **Neat, mounded clumps reaching about 50 cm tall and 45 cm wide**

## COREO

### Solar Moon

- **Soft butter-yellow daisies (~5 cm across) with striking dark red eyes; rebelliously notched petals**
- **Prolific from early summer (June) through late autumn (October); light shearing encourages a second flush**

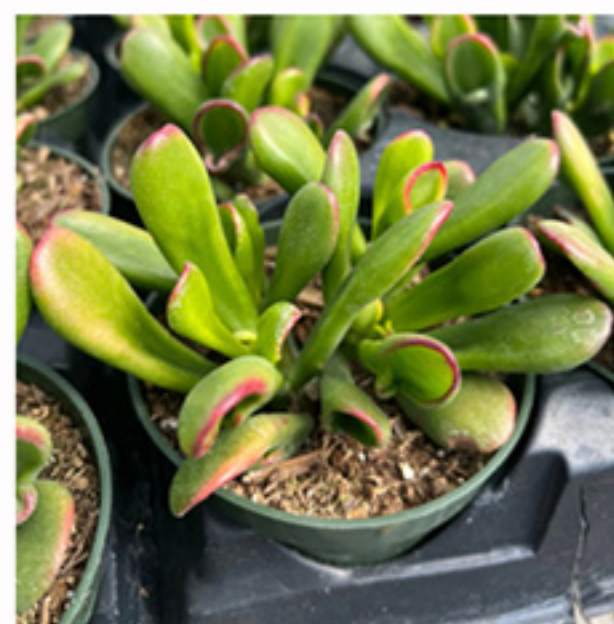
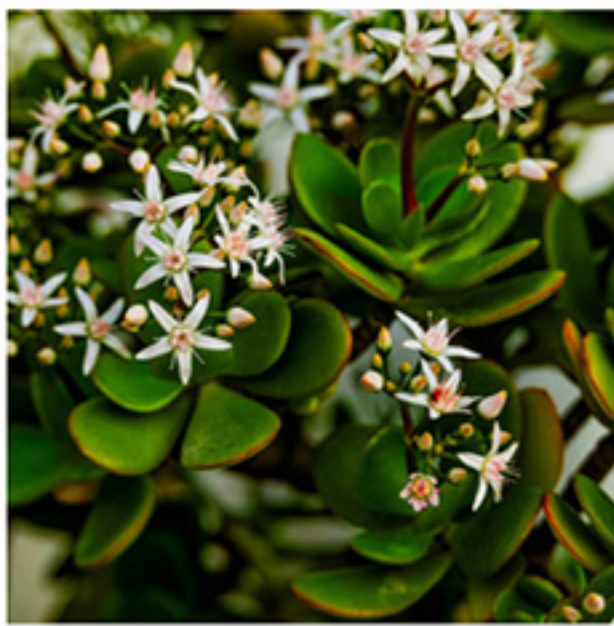
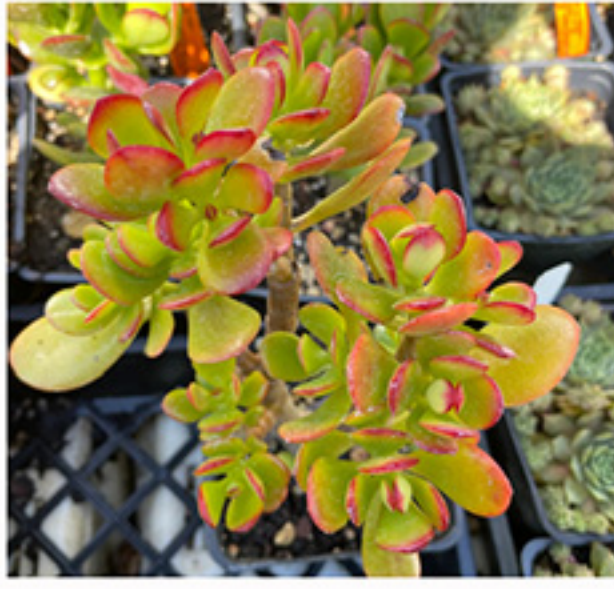
### atrosanguineus

- **Color: Orange–Dark–Red**
- **Leaf color: Green**
- **Produces velvety, dark maroon to nearly black daisy-like flowers, about 3–4 cm wide.**

## Cosmos

### Eclipse

- **Color: Orange–Dark–Red**
- **Leaf color: Green**
- **Features large (~5 cm), broad-petaled blooms in a deep maroon-to-almost-black shade.**



## CRASS

### Aborescens

- **Slow-growing, evergreen succulent shrub reaching 1–3 m tall (usually 30–120 cm when container-grown), with thick woody stems**
- **Opposite, round to oval (3–7 cm long), glaucous grey-green with powdery coating; edges often flush red under sun or stress**

## CRASS

### Minor

- **Compact, branching succulent shrub, typically 30–90 cm tall**
- **Fleshy, glossy, oval leaves ~2–3 cm long; leaves and margins turn deep red under strong sunlight**

## CRASS

### Ovata

- **Glossy, fleshy oval leaves**
- **Produces clusters of small, star-shaped white to pale pink blooms in winter or early spring**
